AMA was developed by the American Medical Association for the purpose of writing medical research. References are found at the end of a manuscript and are titled "Reference List," and each item should be listed in numerical order (two references should not be combined under a single reference number) as opposed to alphabetically.

AMA Manual of Style dictates that one must use endnotes with superscript arabic numerals outside periods and commas, but inside colons and semicolons.

### AMA Citations: A Quick Reference

□ Purposes of references: documentation, acknowledgement, & directing/linking the reader to more information  
□ ALL authors are responsible for ALL reference citations  
□ Always consult primary

source and never cite a reference you yourself have not read □ Whatever reference style is used (e.g. AMA, NLM), consistency is imperative

AMA CITATION STYLE (10TH EDITION) When using the AMA citation style, indication of and information about a cited work, piece of information or idea must appear in two places. You must insert a note within the text of your paper when you make use of a borrowed piece of information and/or idea.

### **British Columbia Institute of Technology**

If no PubMed journal abbreviation exists, use standard abbreviations in the AMA Manual of Style to construct an abbreviated title. Single word titles, such as Pediatrics, are not abbreviated. In journal titles, capitalize all major words (Do not capitalize the, an, a, in, for, or but, unless this word begins the title.)

### **AMA Style Guide**

Author (s) - (or, if no author is available, the name of the organization responsible for the site). Title of the specific item cited (if none is given, use the name of the organization responsible for the site). Name of the website. (use "website" not "Web site") Published date (if available)

The AMA style provides a way to cite (give credit) to the web pages, articles, books and other sources used in research. This guide will help you with creating in-text citations and references, formatting your paper, and other useful information.

### **AMA Style Guide : Home**

AMA 10th edition citation style is based on superscript and Arabic numerals (1, 2, 3, etc.). It means that your in-text citations and references list are closely connected because whatever source you mention in text first is going to be the first in a final list as well. Place numbers right after the fact or quote you mention.
