To use focus lock, you need to set your camera to single shot autofocus mode (AF-S). Then, frame the scene so your subject is in the centre and half-press the shutter release until the camera focuses.

10 camera settings you need to learn to master your Nikon ...
In manual exposure mode, you control both shutter speed and aperture. Shutter speed can be set to values between 30s and V4,000s, or the shutter can be held open for indefinitely for longer exposures (bu _b). Aperture can be set to values between the minimum and max imum values for the lens.
