Oil paints feature pigments that are suspended in oil (typically linseed) while acrylics have their colors bound using acrylic polymer emulsion. Acrylics can be thinned with water, but oil paints require more care. To thin the pigment or clean your brushes, you'll have to use turpentine or mineral spirits.

A 'support' is the name given to a supporting surface for oil paint. It should be stable and able to accept whatever material and technique you wish to use upon it. Wood panels, stretched canvas, hardboard, canvas board, MDF, paper and cardboard, oil painting paper and metal are the most common supports.

Oil Painting Technique 1 - Scumbling Scumbling is the technique of applying a very thin amount of paint using a stiff bristled brush in a kind of broken glaze. The result is a textured effect which leaves some of the underpainting exposed. Scumbling is a dry-brush technique where little or no additional medium is used.
